From Australia, the airline offers eight weekly nonstop flights - five from Sydney and three from Melbourne - to China's southern gateway, Guangzhou (formerly Canton), with onward connections to destinations throughout China, and beyond to neighbouring locations in Asia and long haul international ports in Europe, Africa, the Middle East and the USA.

China Southern's young Airbus A330-200 takes passengers from Australia to Guangzhou, taking advantage of a spacious Premium Economy Class featuring 24 Minipod sleeper seats, each encased in a special "privacy shell".

In addition to its current fleet of Airbus, Boeing and Embraer jets, China Southern was among the first carriers in the world to order new Boeing 787 Dreamliner and Airbus A380 Super Jumbo aircraft to meet its ambitious growth plans.

China Southern is also one of the newest members of the SkyTeam global airline alliance, which serves over 840 destinations in 162 countries, enabling the airline and its partners to offer a vast new range of international travel options.

China Southern passengers who are part of the carrier's "Sky Pearl Club" frequent flyer program are now able to redeem their reward points on flights by China Southern or other SkyTeam member airlines.
